Painting

Year 6 -

- Know how to create imaginative work from a variety of sources e.g. observational drawing, themes.
- Know how to mix and match colours to create atmosphere and light effects.

Upper KS2

Year 5 -

- Know how to mix and match colours to create atmosphere and light effects.
- Know how to identify and work with complementary and contrasting colours

Year 4 -

- Know how to create different effects and textures including blocking in colour, washes, thickened paint creating textural effects.
- Know how to work on a range of scales e.g. thin brush on small picture etc.
- Know how to use line, tone, shape and colour to referent form and movement
- Know how to Print onto different materials

Lower KS2

Year 3 -

- Know how to create different effects and textures with paint according to what they need for the task.
- Know how to create printing blocks using a relief or impressed method.
- Know how to create a two-colour print.
- Know how to mix colours and use tints and shades.

Year 2 -

- Know how to mix secondary colours and brown
- Know how to create tints and tones by adding white or black
- Know how to change and modify fabrics, knotting, fraying, fringing, pulling threads, twisting, plaiting.
- Know how to apply decoration using beads, buttons, feathers, glue etc.
- Know how to use fabrics by weaving materials i.e. grass through twigs
