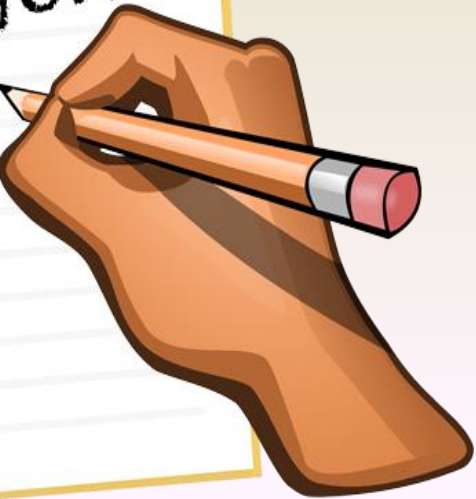

What joys do I experience in my community?

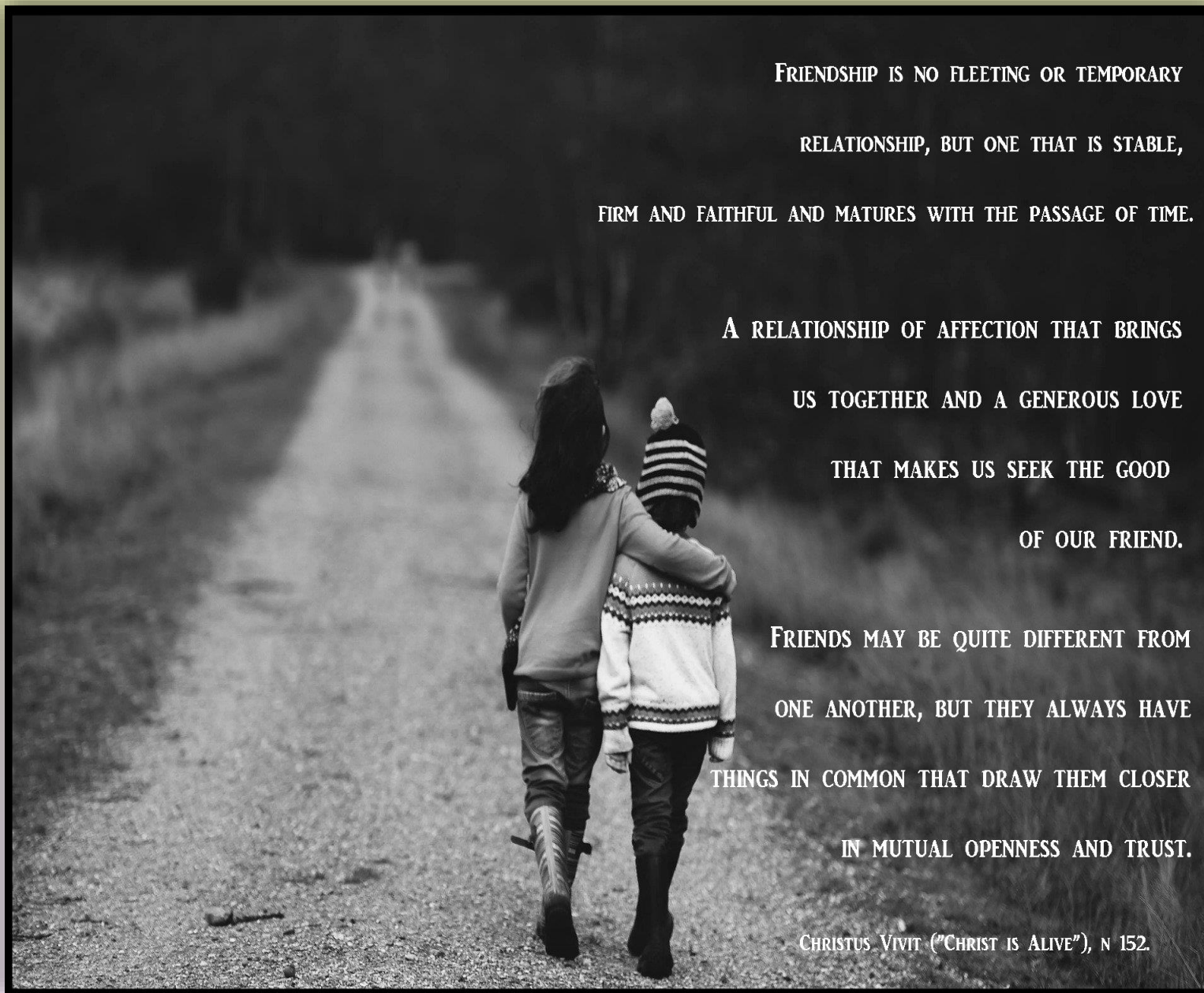

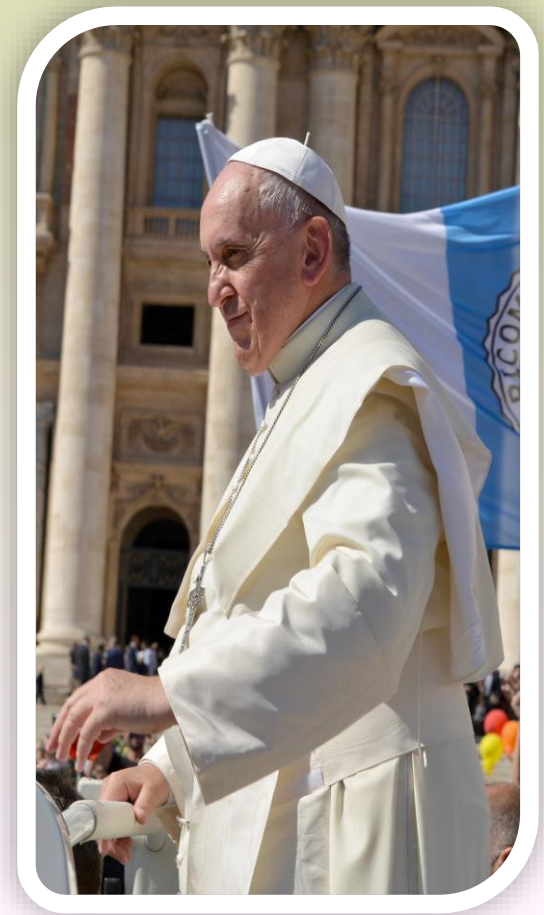
