During the Autumn term, we conducted a survey around parent opinion on **HOMEWORK**. We had an incredible amount of feedback and we have used this to review our current homework offer.



From the feedback received, parents have requested guidance in helping them support their child in home learning rather than formal homework. Parents have request some form of access to resources to work alongside their child so we have been exploring the best ways to do this. As a result of our research we have teamed up with "Learning with Parents".

This is an online portal that allows teachers to allocate an aspect of learning related to their childs current class learning and set an activity that parents can complete with their child at home.

Parents will have their own personal login to access the portal. Each activity has a supporting video and 3 activities to choose from. Each activity uses resources from around the home and make learning fun but meaningful. Parents will be able to add comments and when children complete an activity, they will receive a reward.



We understand that sometimes **WIFI** and data can be a challenge but we can help with this and Learning from parents can issue a **SIM** card with data for families that need it.

There is a reading log but we are just exploring this to see if this is a suitable replacement for the reading log books we currently use. We will keep you updated.

As a school have purchased this resource until the end of the school year and at the end of the year we will ask parents to share their thoughts around this resource. If it is well used, we will renew our subscription ready for September.

We will be hosting a launch event in the new year and arrange a session for parents to see it in action. Watch out for your invite.
